



Asbestos and Poisons Disposal Day

The Town of Victoria Park will be conducting an Asbestos and Poisons Disposal Day for ratepayers and occupants of residential properties.

When: Saturday 3rd November 2007 between 9.00am and 1.00pm

Where: Bring your asbestos and poisons to 218 Planet Street Welshpool.

How: All asbestos products must be wrapped in black “builders” plastic and sealed with tape prior to transportation to the site. Asbestos not wrapped will not be accepted.

- Each household is limited to the equivalent of three (3) fence sheets only
- Any unidentifiable poisons / chemicals may be subject to identification on the day
- Ensure all poison containers have not corroded and are in a safe condition prior to transporting
- Commercial quantities of asbestos, poisons and paint will not be accepted on the day



Note:

- Fibrous cement products manufactured after 1987 do not contain asbestos fibres, however those manufactured prior to 1987 may do so.
- Proof of occupancy within the Town of Victoria Park is required on the day
- Please exercise due care whilst handling any chemical or asbestos products
- Depositors may be responsible for assisting in the handling of their waste at the collection site, and all bundles must be of a manageable size.
