Weddings and Events at G O Edwards Gazebo



The Gazebo at G. O. Edwards Park will hold approximately 60 people and overlooks an ornamental lake full of birdlife, with a water fountain providing a beautiful backdrop.

The Gazebo has power and being surrounded by picturesque parkland gardens is ideal for your wedding photography. Adjacent to the gazebo is the Town's Heritage Circle which provides a snapshot of the Town's history and a perfect backdrop for those artistic and unique photos.



Fees and Charges

Gazebo Hire: \$50.00 per hour or part hour inclusive of GST.

Power: Should you require access to the Town's power supply it can be accessed for a \$15.00 charge.

Bonds: A bond of \$200.00 is required for any vehicle access to the park or the erection of a marquee. A \$50.00 key bond will be required for keys to access the power box, toilets or gates.

All bonds are fully refundable on return of the keys, providing there is no damage to the park.

Vehicle Access

During the summer months Council allows bridal car access to the park for the arrival or departure of the bridal party. Vehicle access from May through to September will be at the discretion of the Parks Supervisor and will depend on prior weather conditions.

Vehicle access is restricted to the bridal car, and the car is not permitted to remain on the park. Parking on or accessing the reserve without permission may incur an infringement from Ranger Services. Bridal vehicles must travel at walking pace and remain on the perimeter tracks and may not drive directly across the lawns. Horse and carriage access is permitted subject to approval by the Parks Supervisor.

Decorations

It is possible to decorate the Gazebo for your wedding. At the close of the

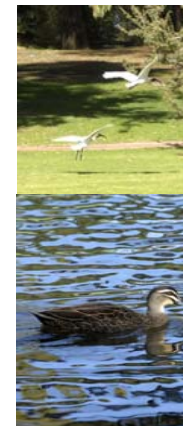
ceremony all decorations must be removed from the area and the Gazebo left in its original condition in readiness for the next hirer.

Parking

Parking for your guests is available at either of Council's car parks at Burswood Road or Hawthorne Place. Both have accessible parking.

Confetti

The lake at G O Edwards Park is a sensitive natural



environment providing a safe nesting place for an array of birdlife.

Therefore the throwing of confetti or rice is not permitted.

Rose petals or bubbles provide

an acceptable alternative.

Refreshments

The supply of food and alcohol to your guests before or after the wedding is allowed, subject to prior permission and compliance with 'Local Laws'.
